

Transport of two Steam Generators from Milan to Porto Marghera (Italy)

Two steam generators were manufactured by Ansaldo Camozzi at their factory in Milan, Italy.

The generators weighing 550 tonnes each were transported to a factory located in Porto Marghera.

Fagioli PSC performed the transport of these two pieces in several stages:

1. Loading of the sections onto the road convoy using a gantry crane at the Ansaldo Camozzi workshop.
2. Transportation by road using a modular trailer from Ansaldo workshop to the port of Cremona.
3. River transport from port of Cremona to Porto Marghera by barge.
4. Unloading on to the jetty at Porto Marghera by Fagioli's vessel "Storman Asia".
5. Road transport from the jetty to the factory using a 16 axle line SPMT.
